First hyperbaric chamber treatment available in the Big Horn Basin region!

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It is estimated that 6.7 million people currently live with chronic wounds and that number is expected to grow at more than two percent for the next decade. The increase is fueled by an aging population and increasing rates of diseases and conditions such as diabetes, obesity and the late effects of radiation therapy. Untreated chronic wounds can lead to diminished quality of life and possibly amputation of the affected limb.

Our new West Park Wound Care Center is designed to complement your physicians' services and is committed to the treatment of chronic or non-healing wounds. The Center is made up of a team of professionals, including:

- » Physicians with advanced training in wound management and hyperbaric oxygen therapy
- » Nursing staff trained in the care of chronic wounds
- » Technicians who perform non-invasive studies and various therapies
- » Experienced staff to assist with appointments, medical records, and health insurance processing
- » A personalized wound treatment program

COMMUNITY PARAMEDICINE

The Foundation will be fundraising for West Park Hospital's new innovative service called Community Paramedicine. Recently approved by the State of Wyoming, Community Paramedicine has Paramedics operating in expanded roles in non-emergency settings, performing assessments, treatments, prevention and referrals.

Our Community Paramedics will receive referrals from physicians to make outbound calls on patients who do

not qualify for Home Health Services. Patients might need help in a number of areas which may include:

- » Homefall assessment and safety evaluations
- » Medication compliance and medication reconciliation
- » Lab and specimen draws
- » Diabetes compliance including dietary choices and glucose checks
- » Wound care assessment and wound dressing
